DIY Paper Tuning Stand




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LIST OF MATERIALS

Qty	Description
22'	1" PVC Pipe
1	Roll of Paper
3	Large Clamps
3'	1/2" PVC Pipe
2	1" Elbow fitting
6	1" T-connectors
2	1" to 1/2" T-Connector
2	½" Elbow fitting
4	1" End Caps



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NOTES

- The diagram is not exactly to scale, but the dimensions will have anyone from 5'8" 6'4" shooting through the paper.
- The smaller you can get the PVC pipe that you put the paper on, the better, but when using 1" PVC pipe for the frame, I think the smallest "T" connector that went from a 1" was a ½"
- The "Large Clamps" are to hold the paper at the top of the frame and then I put one on the roll to keep the paper tight where I am going to shoot through.
- The I chose not to glue / cement any of the piece together, in case I wanted to take it a part for any reason. You can glue / cement the stand, but the parts I definitely would not is the following:
 - Legs (makes it easier for storing)
 - Part where the roll of paper goes on (so you can put on a new roll when you run out



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
